DESCRIPTION OF INSTITUTIONS:

Michigan State University (MSU): MSU is a Research I public university in East Lansing, Michigan. MSU frequently ranks among the top public universities in the United States and the top 100 research universities in the world. MSU's political science department boasts an exceptionally talented and productive research faculty and currently houses the prestigious *American Journal of Political Science* as well as two other journals. Class sizes range from 25 to 250.

Hope College (Hope): Hope College is a private, residential liberal arts college in Holland, Michigan. Hope College emphasizes exceptional teaching, undergraduate research, and experiential learning. It is listed by Loren Pope as one of the forty "Colleges that Change Lives." Class sizes ranged from 10 to 35 students.

University of Michigan ICPSR Summer Program (UofM): The ICPSR Summer Program, housed at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, Michigan, offers a series of courses that allow students rigorous, hands-on training in statistical techniques, research methods, and data analysis. Participants represent more than 30 different disciplines and come from more than 350 colleges, universities, and organizations around the world.
